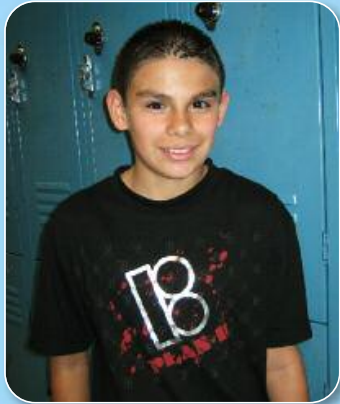




# LANDMARKS OF NANTUCKET!
