Conditions of use

Access to collections in the Nantucket Historical Association Research Library, including materials on the web, is not authorization to publish from them. Separate written application for permission to publish must be made to the Nantucket Historical Association (NHA).

The NHA can grant permission to publish materials for which it holds the copyright, and these include

- Printed materials published by NHA
- Materials in manuscript collections for which the donor has given copyright to the NHA

The copyright law of the United States (Title 17, United States Code) does not allow us to grant permission to publish materials we do not clearly own and puts the burden on the researcher to identify the holder of the copyright and obtain permission. We do not hold copyright for materials in NHA records not created in the course of conducting NHA business or in manuscript collections if the author has not specifically given copyright to the NHA. It is the job of the researcher to determine the holder of copyright and pursue the copyright owner or his or her heirs for permission to publish if the NHA does not hold the copyright.

Use fees

The NHA reserves the right to levy use fees on the use of material from its manuscript holdings. Chiefly use fees are reserved for commercial use or for “republishing” works in their entirety, and not considered for citations.

Citation guidelines

When permission to publish material is granted, the researcher must identify the location of the originals in the NHA Research Library. Citation of materials from NHA records and manuscript collections should include the full name of the library (Nantucket Historical Association Research Library), the number of the collection, the name of the collection, and the specific location.
